ROAD CLOSURE – GRANT STREET

- WHAT:** Grant Street and Park Avenue storm drainage improvement project
- WHEN:** January 19 – February 6
- IMPACT:** Portions of Grant Street will be closed intermittently, at the intersection of Park Avenue, and access for through traffic will be affected. Detour signs will be posted to direct motorists to alternate routes. The sidewalk along Park Avenue will also be closed. Pedestrians will be directed to Third Street.
