TOWN-WIDE SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK OF APRIL 3-7

Herndon, VA (March 16, 2017) – The annual spring clean-up will take place throughout the Town of Herndon during the week of April 3-7. Spring clean-up provides an opportunity for residents to place large or bulky items curbside for pick-up on their scheduled trash collection day. Items can include:

- Appliances (remove doors)
- Furniture
- Vehicle parts and plumbing fixtures (all under 50 lbs.)
- Tires (maximum 2 per household)
- Limited amount of building materials (approximately one cubic yard, lengths not to exceed 4 feet)

Loose yard waste, auto parts in excess of 50 lbs., large quantities of building materials, brick & block, electronics (including televisions, stereos, computers & peripheral) and household hazardous waste will NOT be picked up.

Items should be placed curbside by 7am on your trash day only, but no earlier than 24 hours prior to pick-up.
