RESOLUTION

JUNE 10, 2014

Resolution- Repealing the resolution encouraging the use of the English language for Town business.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Town of Herndon that:

1. The Town Council repeals the following measure:

Resolution 07-G-35, adopted March 27, 2007, “To encourage individuals who interact with the Town to strive to learn English, which is the primary language in which Town business is conducted; to recognize and appreciate those in our community who teach English for Speakers of Other Languages; and to recognize and appreciate those newcomers to our community who are learning English.” However, nothing in this resolution adopted June 10, 2014 affects the Town Manager’s inherent power to translate official Town business literature into languages other than English in cases involving the (i) health, safety, or welfare of Town residents or (ii) the application for Federal or State grants.

2. This resolution shall be effective on and after the date of its adoption.
