Resolution- Providing Recreational Benefits the Herndon Police Citizens' Support Team.

WHEREAS, the Herndon Police Citizens' Support Team (HPCST) was formally organized in 1976; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the HPCST is to aid, support and assist the Herndon Police in the prevention of crime and promote public safety; and

WHEREAS, the town recognizes the many dedicated hours of volunteer service the HPCST provides to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Herndon, Virginia, that to recognize the dedicated service of the HPCST the following recreation benefits are provided:

- Golf Course – free greens fees during non-prime time and usage of carts on an as available basis as determined by the Golf Professional.
- Racquetball – free court time for the employee and 50 percent of cost for partners on an as available basis. Reservations cannot be made sooner than 24 hours ahead of requested court time.
- Swimming – free during any open swimming time.
- Lockers – free usage.
- Tennis – free court time for the employee and 50 percent cost for partner when fees are charged on an as available basis.
- Fitness Room – free use of equipment.
- Basketball – free basketball court usage during lunch time.
- Discount Classes – 25 percent discount on classes off the Fairfax County residence rate regardless of residence.
- HPCST members must provide a town issued identification card as a means of identification.
