

Herndon Downtown Redevelopment - Update

The Herndon Downtown Redevelopment Project, a partnership between the Town of Herndon and Comstock Herndon Venture LC, received site plan approval from the town's planning staff on April 9. Comstock has resubmitted its application to the town's Heritage Preservation Review Board, which will consider the plan at an upcoming public hearing. Construction on the project, which includes 273 residential apartments, 17,000 square feet of retail space, an 18,000 square foot Arts Center and a 787-space parking garage, is expected to get under way in late 2019.



Because of the planned project, the Herndon Festival is moving from its downtown location to a new site at the Northwest Federal Credit Union, 200 Spring Street. For information on the new location as well as Festival sponsorship opportunities, visit herndonfestival.net.

Town of Herndon Proposed FY 2020 Budget

Town Manager Bill Ashton has presented to the Herndon Town Council a proposed FY 2020 Budget that calls for maintenance of the town's real estate tax at its current level; and an increase in the town's meals tax, from 2.5 percent to 3.5 percent, to fund ongoing capital improvements.
