Robbery-Person **9/2/2019** **Van Buren St/Spring St** **2019-02974**
Robbery-Person **9/4/2019** **800-blk Ferndale Ave** **2019-02998**
 Three juvenile males (ages 13, 14, and 15), all of Herndon, VA, have been arrested in connection with two robberies. In both cases, the suspects approached the victims while the victims were walking alone at night/early in the morning and robbed them of their belongings. Additional charges are pending. All the suspects are being held at the Fairfax County Juvenile Detention Center.

Assault-Aggravated **9/12/2019** **1100-blk Autumn Haze Ct** **2019-03099**
 The victim reported that he was riding his bicycle home in the early morning hours when he was approached by a group of juveniles/teenagers. The victim was then assault by one of the juveniles. The victim was transported to Reston Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect, juvenile male (17 years old), of Herndon, VA, was identified and arrested a short time later. He is currently being held at the Fairfax County Juvenile Detention Center.

Burglary-Residential **9/10/2019** **700-blk Hickory Ct** **2019-03070**
 The victims stated that sometime in the overnight hours between Monday, September 9, 2019 and Tuesday, September 10, 2019, an unknown number of subjects entered the home through a back, sliding glass door. There were no signs of forced entry. Multiple items of value were taken from the home. The case is under investigation.

Robbery-Person **9/14/2019** **Herndon PW/Cypress Tree Pl** **2019-03131**
 Christopher Geovanny Duarte Alvarado, 23, of Herndon, VA, was arrested on two charges of robbery. He attempted to rob two victims at two separate times; one victim of his dog and the other of his bicycle. Duarte Alvarado was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he is being held without bond.
