



Town Election Results

Keven J. LeBlanc, Jr., has been elected to serve as Mayor of the Town of Herndon for the 2025-2026 term, according to results from the Fairfax County Office of Elections. LeBlanc is currently completing his first term as a councilmember on the Herndon Town Council.



The six Town Councilmembers elected for the new term are Naila Alam, Cesar A. del Aguila, Kelvin Garcia, Clark A. Hedrick, Michael T. Lloyd, and Alexis "Alex" Reyes. Alam, del Aguila and Hedrick serve on the current council.

Election results became official upon certification by the Fairfax County Electoral Board, which administers elections for the Town of Herndon.

The 2025-2026 Mayor and Town Council will assume office on January 1, 2025. A swearing-in ceremony will be held at 6pm on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, just prior to their first work session. The ceremony will be held in the Herndon Council Chambers, 765 Lynn Street, Herndon; all residents are invited to attend.

Leaf Collection

Curbside leaf collection continues through December 13. Town crews alternate weekly between north and south of the W&OD trail. Residents should rake leaves as close to the curb as possible without blocking storm drains, sidewalks or mailboxes and without impeding vehicular traffic. **Please note: collection is not necessarily on your trash day, it may be earlier in the week. Please get leaves out as early as possible, as trucks typically make just one pass-through each week.**

During leaf collection, grass clippings, shrub clippings and weeds must be placed in 30-gallon kraft, recyclable bags and should be placed out on your regular trash day.

Following the scheduled fall collection, leaves must be placed in 30-gallon kraft recyclable bags and will be picked up on regular trash/yard waste collection days.
