WINTER STORM PREPARATION

Snow is in the forecast for Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. Prior to the storm, residents and businesses are asked to please move cars off of roads and cul-de-sacs so the town's snow plows can get through. Please make sure the right-of-way in front of your property is clear.

Once the storm gets under way, plows will begin focusing on main and secondary roads, to ensure access for emergency vehicles. Neighborhoods will be cleared as soon as possible; your patience is appreciated.

Please note: the town does not remove snow from residential or business sidewalks. Please be a good neighbor and clear sidewalks adjacent to your home or business. Do not shovel snow into the streets or block storm drains or fire hydrants. Town crews do remove snow from sidewalks around government facilities - the Herndon Municipal Center, Herndon Community Center, and Herndon Police Department - as well as from brick walkways in the downtown.

Please note that trash will NOT be collected on Wednesday. Residents on Wednesday routes should get bins to the curb for Thursday pickup.

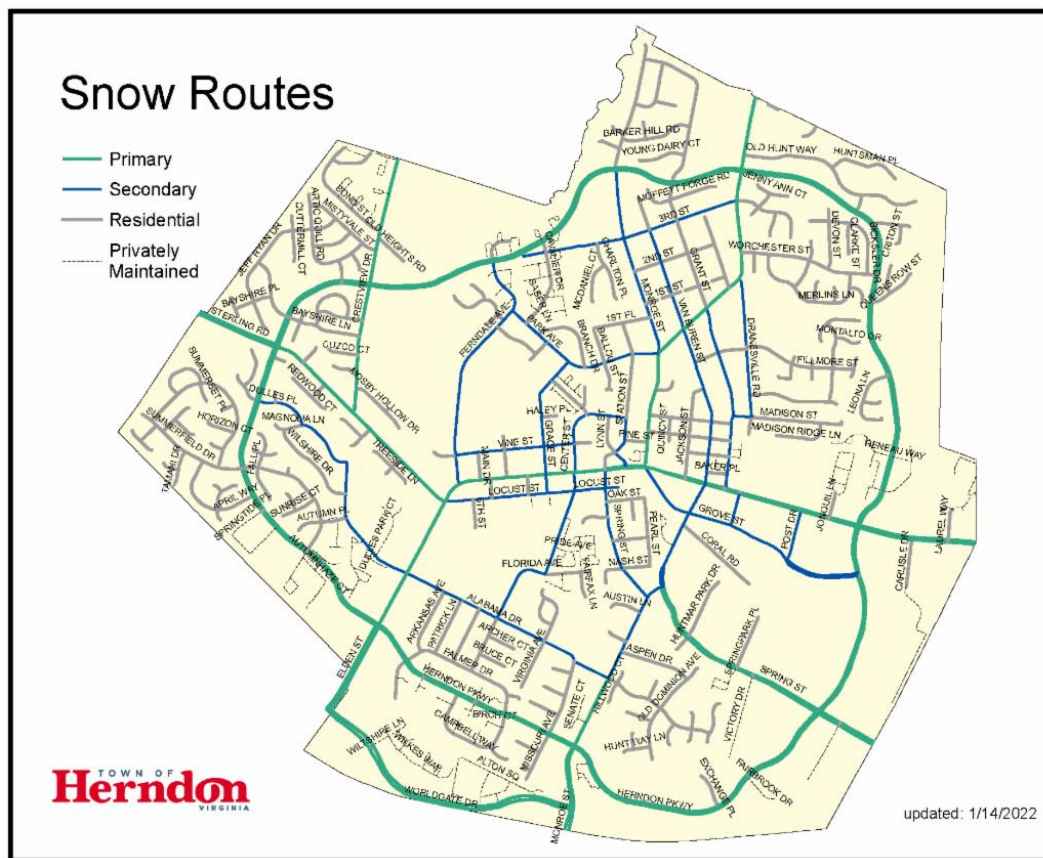
Liberal leave is in effect for non-essential town employees beginning from noon on Tuesday until 6pm on Wednesday. The Herndon Town Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday evening is cancelled.

Information on town openings and closings, to include the Herndon Community Center and its Tuesday and Wednesday programming, will be provided as it is determined.

Power outages should be reported directly to Dominion Power, 1-866-DOM-HELP or www.dom.com. Prepare for outages by charging electrical items such as phones, laptops and other devices in advance, and by keeping them charged.
